Dress Requirements/Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

When attending TAFE, students must ensure they meet the following dress and/or safety requirements:

- Long heavy cotton drill trousers and long sleeve cotton drill shirt
- Enclosed hiking boots (heavy leather uppers and heavy-duty soles)
- Safety glasses must be clear and meet Australian Safety Standards (sunglasses are not permitted)

- Long hair must be tied up or contained.
